Amber is the Partnership Coordinator for Safe House Project, an evangelist, and a lived experienced expert with knowledge in complex trauma and recovery. Amber paved the way for future survivors to hold positions at the YWCA that require degrees by advocating for change in position requirements, allowing lived experiences to be comparable to educational degrees in the field of crisis intervention. As the shelter case manager, she successfully advocated and gained affordable housing for hundreds of victims of domestic violence and sexual assault.

Under her leadership at Survivor Ventures, Amber collaborated with the local tattoo artists community and created a program that provides free 'cover ups' for survivors who have experienced 'branding'. Additionally, she partnered with several dental offices to provide quality dental repair to survivors; restoring a smile they can be proud of.

Amber has spoken on many platforms as a keynote speaker, including a National Human Trafficking Conference in 2013, GROW Foundation's annual fundraiser in 2023, and the Navy's first updated Sexual Assault Prevention and Response training video in two decades. Today, Amber is committed to empowering the faith community to become mobilized in identifying and supporting survivors of sex trafficking in the church and acknowledging the power of God and his heart to restore the lost and broken.
