Additionally, Safe House Project convenes more than 500 stakeholders in the Trafficking Survivor Equity Coalition.

As a human trafficking expert who is regularly advising federal and state legislators as well as fortune 500 companies, Kristi is helping advance a coordinated, collaborative, public-private national response to trafficking in America.
