At HTI, Lindsey serves as the lead architect and author of the annual Federal Human Trafficking Report, where she manages the data collection and analysis of federal human trafficking cases filed in the United States each year. She briefs government leaders and other anti-trafficking stakeholders on key findings and emerging trends to improve prosecution of traffickers.

In addition, Lindsey stewards HTI's Thought Leadership team, oversees HTI's Frederick Douglass Fellowship program, and advocates for innovative and data-driven strategies for combatting human trafficking based on victim-centered, trauma informed enforcement models. Lindsey serves as HTI's country program attorney in Belize where she assists in training stakeholders in best practices for investigating and prosecuting human trafficking cases.

Lindsey is an experienced prosecutor and trial attorney at both the State and Federal level, most recently serving as a designated state human trafficking prosecutor. Lindsey is a graduate of Salem Women's College and Liberty University School of Law.
