BE ON WATCH WHEN YOU TRAVEL

5 SIGNS OF TRAFFICKING

IF YOU SUSPECT SOMEONE IS TRAFFICKED CONTACT CONTACT AIRPORT SECURITY IMMEDITATELY.

IF A PERSON

IS NOT IN POSSESSION OF THEIR OWN PAPERWORK

In order to maintain compliance and complicate escape, traffickers will keep possession of their victim's tickets, identification paperwork, and any other items that could allow the victim to switch flights or leave.

IS NEVER UNATTENDED

Victims will not be permitted to go to the food court, be left at gates, or even go to the restroom alone. Anywhere they go, their trafficker is with them.

DOES NOT SPEAK OR Make eye contact

Victims are taught not to do anything that will bring attention to themselves. You will not remember a conversation with them. All necessary interaction will be with the person they are flying with.

SEEMS TENSE, ANXIOUS, OR FEARFUL

While flying is a source of tension and anxiety for many people, this indicator will present itself by being directed at the people around the victim or at the trafficker. They may seem less afraid of flying and more afraid to be leaving with the person with them.

DOES NOT KNOW FLIGHT DETAILS SUCH AS GATE, AIRLINE, OR DESTINATION

In order to keep victims from knowing what is happening or changing flights, and as a scare tactic, traffickers will keep information from their victims as a way to control them.
