In the United States, sex trafficking is the second largest illegal industry with hundreds of thousands of Americans trafficked every year.



Sex trafficking is the commercial sexual exploitation of an individual through force, fraud, or coercion. Minors under the age of 18 are victims of sex trafficking, regardless of the use of force, fraud, or coercion. **There is no such thing as a child prostitute**.

In 2003, the National Center for Missing & Exploited Children reviewed 450K child sexual abuse files, in 2019 they reviewed 70 million files.

- The average age of entry into the commercial sex market is 12 years old.

- While anyone can be a victim, we know that kids who are homeless or runaways, LGBTQ, African American or Latino, and youth interacting with the child welfare system are more vulnerable to exploitation.
- 35% of child victims are boys.

- 40% of children served by Safe House Project and its partners have been trafficked by a family member.

During COVID, the National Center for Missing & Exploited Children have seen a 90.46% increase of calls to the Cyber Tip Line, and the National Human Trafficking Hotline has seen a 40% increase in calls.
